**Transport Guide**

At Warrington Collegiate we understand that travel to College is an important factor when choosing where to study and we are committed to ensuring that your journey to College is as convenient as possible. Warrington Collegiate is located on Winwick Road to the north of Warrington town centre and is well served by a range of public transport. This guide aims to provide general information about the transport options available to you, and more detailed guidance is available from our Learner Services team on 01925 494494.

## Warrington Collegiate Free Bus Service

From September 2011, Warrington Collegiate will operate a bus service for the convenience of our students. Details of these services are outlined below and travel to the College is free. For further information please contact our Learner Services team.

<b>Route A:</b>	Culcheth via Warrington Road, Birchwood, Fearnhead and Padgate to Warrington Collegiate
<b>Route B:</b>	Lymm via Appleton Thorne, Stretton, Stockton Heath, Chester Road and Latchford to Warrington Collegiate
<b>Route C:</b>	St Helens, Widnes Town Centre, Penketh, Great Sankey and Bewsey to Warrington Collegiate

Buses will operate on College days only and will arrive at Warrington Collegiate shortly before 9 am.\*

## Subsidised Bus Passes

If you are aged between 16 – 19 years, and live in the Warrington area, you will be entitled to a Warrington Borough Transport (WBT) half price bus pass. A Town Network or Town Saver Pass can be purchased for unlimited travel on WBT buses. Bus passes can be purchased from Registry. You will need to bring a passport sized photograph for your ticket. Alternatively you can purchase your pass from the Bus Station in Warrington town centre. Additional financial support may also be available to help with travel costs. Please call in or telephone Learner Services for more information.

If you are aged 19 or over you may also be eligible to receive support from the College for your travel. Please call in or telephone Learner Services for more information. If you are registered disabled and are a resident in the Warrington area you may be eligible for support. Please contact Warrington Borough Transport on 01925 442629 for further information.

## Train Services

The College can be accessed via regular train services to either Warrington Bank Quay [from Frodsham, Runcorn and Newton-le-Willows] or Warrington Central [from Widnes]. Both stations are situated close to the town centre and are approximately a 25 minute walk from our Winwick Road campus. Alternatively a bus service is available to the campus from the town centre.

## Cycling to College

Cycling to the College is encouraged and the College has a number of cycle racks where you can secure your cycle.

## Driving to and parking at the College

Warrington Collegiate is conveniently located on Winwick Road (A49) to the north of the town centre and is easily accessed from both the M6 (Junction 22) and the M62 (Junction 9).
