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The purpose of the Student Disciplinary / Positive Behaviour Management Procedure is as follows:

- to ensure student behaviour is managed positively in order that students achieve their learning goals successfully
- to ensure that students adopt reasonable behaviour and conduct whilst on Colleges premises
- to ensure that all students receive consistent and fair treatment when involved in student disciplinary procedures.

The policy should be implemented by all staff and applies to all students attending courses at Warrington Collegiate, whether full time or part time. It also applies to students associated with third parties who are studying on College premises (such as Xtra Options pupils). 'College premises' includes residentials, trips, field study, work placements, and sporting/social activities organised by the College. This policy also applies to any behaviour which occurs outside of College that has the potential to bring the College into disrepute.
